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Installation

Extract and copy plugin files to the "plugins" directory. Go to WordPress -> Dashboard -> Plugins and activate Premium Wordpress Login Notifications. If you have trouble with installation, please email stefany@stefanywebdesign.info

Setup / Getting Started

After activating the plugin, go to Settings -> Premium Wordpress Login Notifications . A settings form will appear. By default, the administrator role will be automatically checked and the email will be set to the one you installed WordPress with.

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How to use

Fieldsets breakdown

- 1. First fieldset *User roles you want login activity notifications for* are checkboxes with all user roles (user roles in WordPress are the "titles" of all users in your website, like administrator or author or receptionist) that have access to the admin panel. Those can be subscribers or admins.
 - a. Custom user roles will be listed ONLY if they can access the admin panel
 - b. NOTE: WooCommerce roles like shop manager or customer will be listed but notifications will only be send if they login with the wp-login form, not the /user-account login form. This is a WordPress plugin, not a WooCommerce one so WooCommerce functionality is limited
 - c. Checking the box next to the role name will make it "tracked" i.e. a notification will be sent when they login and the log will be populated IF log is added
- 2. Second fieldset *Addresses you want to receive notifications at:* is list of emails you want to get notifications at. Separate them with a comma if you want to receive alerts on more than one, just like you would in the to field of a email client
 - a. For example if you add example2@example2.com all tracked role activity will be sent to BOTH emails
 - b. If no email is added OR emails are defective, no emails will be send
- 3. Third fieldset Store the log serves two purposes:
 - a. It has the option to enable/disable logging the tracked user's activity
 - b. It provides a link to download the log
 - i. Check the box to log the tracked roles
 - ii. When the log has entries, a link appears named "Download the log in CSV format:" and when clicked will download the log (admins ONLY can do that)
 - iii. Log contains this user data:
 - 1. Username
 - 2. Role
 - 3. Website URL (aka your website URL)
 - 4. Time of Login
 - 5. IP they logged from
 - 6. Timezone of the time of login (so you'd know if they logged from a different timezone)
- 4. The last fieldset *DO NOT receive notifications if users log in from these IPs:* contains IP addresses you DO NOT WANT to receive notifications for when they logged in.
 - a. If pressed, no notifications will be send if tracked users login from the listed IPS.
 - b. For example, if you add the IP 127.0.0.1 and the user John with the role of admin logs in from the IP 127.0.0.1, no notification OR LOG will be issued. However, if

John goes to Australia and logs in with the SAME account, notifications will be send and/or logged

Timezones

Plugin uses the WordPress timezone defined in Settings -> General

FAQ

What happens if I have emails added but unchecked the log?

Only emails will be send and no log will be stored

What happens if I have checked the log but haven't added any emails?

Log will be stored, but no emails issued.

What happens if I have unchecked the log and haven't added any emails?

Nothing. You will receive no notifications.

How to temporarily turn off ALL notifications?

Go to Plugins -> Premium Wordpress Login Notifications and click "Deactivate". Deactivating the plugin WILL NOT delete any data or settings, but will temporary suspend it.

What if I want the plugin to do something out of the ordinary but doesn't have the functionality yet?
